
Academics: Sequoia Graduation Requirements

Credits: 220 total credits

Courses:

- 40 credits of English
- 35 credits of Social Studies
- 20 credits of Science (10 credits must be lab)
- <u>20 credits</u> Math (10 credits Algebra & 10 credits Geometry)
- **10 credits** of Fine Arts/Visual & Performing Arts
- <u>10 credits</u> of Career Technical Ed/CTE (OR 3rd level of World Language)
- <u>20 credits</u> of P.E. (OR 10 credits may be met through 3 seasons of sports in grades 10-12)
- **2.5 credits** of Life Skills
- 62.5 credits of Electives

Post-Secondary: A-G Requirements



A-G Requirements UC/CSU 4 year colleges

- Students must complete A-G
 courses and earn a "C-" or higher
 to be <u>eligible</u> for admission.
- Students are encouraged to exceed the minimum requirements to be <u>competitive!</u>

* Grades of C or better required.

SAT & ACT Exams

- Sign-up in the Spring of Junior year for the SAT and/or ACT. Retake the SAT and/or ACT in the Fall of Senior year, if needed.
- Fee waivers available in the College & Career Center for students that qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch.
- Khan Academy: Link your College Board account with Kahn Academy to create free, customized SAT test prep.
- Apply for Free/Reduced Lunch every year for other fee waivers (AP/IB exams).

Smarter Balanced (SBAC) Assessments-April 2019

- "California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)" aka SBAC
- Take these exams <u>seriously!</u>
- Authorize the school to release your scores to CSU by pressing the release button at the end of the CAASPP assessment for English Language Arts /Literacy and Math (the authorization must be done for each one separately).
- Scores may impact your English & Math Placements for CSU
- May be <u>required</u> to attend CSU Early Start Program (EAP) during the summer after graduation

Letters of Recommendation (LOR): Private, EOP, Scholarships & College Essays

- LOR-Two teachers max + counselor
- LOR-General Recommendations; (1) Humanities, (1) STEM
- LOR- 11th grade teacher, ask in spring semester
- LOR- Counselors have a process
- Essays- Common Application, UC Personal Insight
 Questions, Supplemental Questions

Concurrent Enrollment Acceleration, Enrichment, Recovery

- Concurrent Enrollment = FREE Community College Courses
- Can take up to 11 units per semester for free as a high school student in the Fall and/or Spring. 6 units in the summer.
- Applications available in the Guidance Office & College/Career Center.
- See your counselor for more information.

- Make sure you meet all deadlines for changes regarding your 2019-2020 course requests. Due by May 24th.
- Choose your alternate courses carefully as your first choice is not guaranteed.
- Course requests subject to change based on teacher recommendations.






Sequoia ENGLISH Pathway




Sequoia ENGLISH Pathway




Sequoia WORLD LANGUAGE Pathway:
