# **Graduation Requirements**

### Credits are required for graduation!

- 2.5 earned for quarter classes (Life Skills/PE)
- 5 earned for semester classes in December & June (Examples: English, Math, Science)
- D- or higher is passing, okay for graduation
- C- or higher is required for 4 year colleges
- F grades do not give you credit
- D/F grades do not meet 4 year college requirements
- Final grades are permanent on transcript
- Attendance is important
- 9th grade DOES matter!

### Sequoia Graduation Requirements

220 credits are required for graduation requirements

English	4 years (40 Credits)
Social Studies	3.5 years (35 credits)
Math	2 years (20 credits) *Algebra and Geometry
Science	2 years (20 credits) *1 year lab science
Life Skills	2.5 credits
Fine Art	1 year (10 credits)
PE .	2 years (20 credits)
CTE	1 year (10 credits)
Electives	62.5 credits




