




# **Sequoia MATH Pathway**





## Sequoia Physical Education Options:

#### 20 credits of P.E. are required for graduation requirements

#### Choose your P.E. class for 10th grade:

- P.E. 2
- P.E. Weight Train
- P.E. Conditioning (yoga)
- P.E. Dance (beginners)
- Intermediate Dance (audition required)
- Advanced Dance (audition required)

#### **Alternative Options:**

- **Sequoia Athletics** each season you earn 3.5 credits. Completing 3 seasons of a sport in 10th-12th grades will fulfill the second year requirement for PE. It is recommended that students enroll in a Sequoia P.E. class in the event that sports are not permitted due to health/safety guidelines.
- **Concurrent Enrollment** Students may take fitness courses at CSM, Cañada, or Skyline. 1 semester unit counts as 5 SHS credits. Documentation & approval from your counselor are required.

#### What is Drama class?

The Sequoia Drama program includes two classes: Drama I and II. These are separate from the afterschool productions (plays/musicals). In both courses, we explore acting, playwriting, directing, and tech theatre. We also focus on the power of theatre to affect change and contribute to social justice.

#### Why should I take a Drama class?

You get to participate in unique and creative projects — unlike anything you do in your academic classes. 
