FACTS

All CSU will not look at ACT/SAT for admissions - Test Blind

UC - Right now Berkeley, Irvine and Santa Cruz are Test Blind

Court decision is yet to be confirmed but states all UC will be Test Blind

1550 plus colleges are Test Optional

Every representative I have heard at a virtual conference or spoke to in person has stated it will not negatively affect a student's application

How can it be equal if one student turns in a test score and another does not?

Comprehensive Review - school sets what factors to admit students based on their goals and priorities

Need to understand that colleges understand that students are not being given the opportunities so it would be unfair to require

Colleges do not compare one application against another during when reading applications

Reps constantly tell school counselors - it is not one thing that gets you in or out

Should you take the exam?

- Check out all the schools you are applying to, do you need them?
- Have you been preparing?
- Think about how your score will enhance your application?
 - What will they learn about you with that score that they can't see elsewhere
