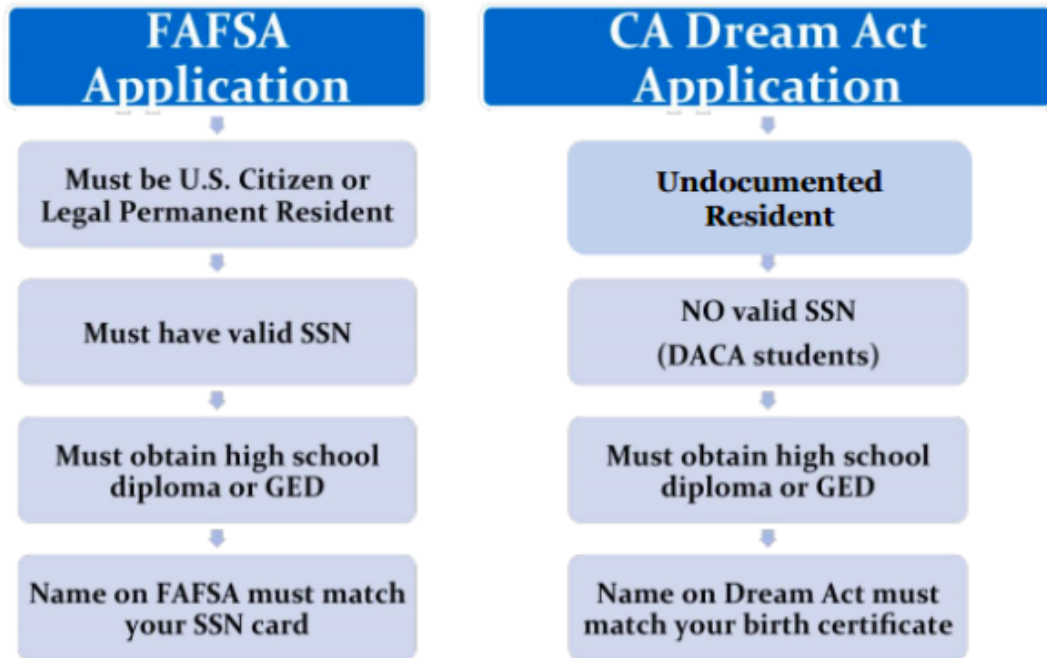


## The 2 types of Financial Aid Application: FAFSA vs. CA DREAM ACT
